

ALPHABETICAL INFORMATION LIST

- Baby sitting** Babysitting services are available for R85/ hour. Please enquire at reception.
- Bar Fridge** All hotel rooms have a bar fridge for your convenience.
- Bird List** If you are interested in bird watching, there is a Bird List available at the reception reflecting which birds you can expect in this area and which have already been spotted on the reserve. Perhaps you can add to our list.
- Braai areas** Please make sure that the fire is **properly out** before leaving the fire or going to bed.
- Canoes** If you would like to go for a boat trip up the river, the canoes are available along the river towards Yellowwood house. It is an easy ride and is highly recommended. Please make sure to anchor boats properly when you are done using them.
- Car Wash** One of our staff members is usually available to wash your car, except on Sundays. If you would like your car washed, please tell us. A small tip of about R50 would be most welcome.
- Coffee/Tea** All units except Yellowwood manor have coffee and tea provided. You will find everything in the cupboard in your room. Machine coffees are charged extra.
- Electricity** Paraffin lamps and candles are provided in case of power failure. The generator will be switched on should power failure persist.
- Emergency** In case of an emergency during the day or if you need to use the phone, please contact anyone at the reception or in the pub. There is a whistle on the room keys that can be used in case of emergencies.
- Feeding animals** Please do not feed any animals on this property. They unfortunately become a menace to other guests.
- Fireplace** The Leopard Suites, Kingfisher, Zebra and Yellowwood cottages have a fire place. Wood is provided at R60 but please, **never leave the fire unattended or go to bed whilst the fire is burning.**

First Aid	In case of an accident, we have a First Aid kit available at reception.
Fishing	Only Fly Fishing is allowed in the trout dams and in the Komati River. Please also read the rules for fly fishermen on our website.
Flies	We have an assortment of Flies available for sale. The cost is R10 per fly.
Forgotten items	If you have forgotten something, please phone and make the necessary arrangements for the item to be returned to you. We will contact you if we find any forgotten items in units.
Game	We have quite a variety of game and other small animals on the reserve and surrounding areas. See our website under
Games	A variety of games are available for you to use. They are kept in the Bar area.
Hairdryers	Hairdryers are available at the reception.
Hiking	We currently have two marked hiking trails. But one can take a walk as far as the eye can see. The road going past the Lodge into the gorge offers beautiful scenery and the occasional spotting of baboons, monkeys and a variety of buck. For other routes, please ask at reception.
Horse riding	Horse rides are available on the reserve. Booking is essential. Please ask at reception.
Map of the area	There is a map of the area on the wall between the pub and the lounge.
Meals in the restaurant	If you stay in one of our self-catering units and would like dinner or breakfast in the restaurant, you will have to book before 13h00 at the reception.
Mealtimes	Mealtimes are as follows: Breakfast is served in "Pat's breakfast nook" from 8h30 to 10h30. Light meals are available from 12h00 until 14h00 in McGinn's pub/restaurant. Dinner is at any time after 18h30, but the kitchen closes at 20h30.
Mountain bikes	We have mountain bikes available. You are welcome to use them to go for a ride. Please ask at reception.

Office hours	The office hours are from 8h00 until 16h00. If you don't find anyone in the office, please have a look in the pub or restaurant.
Payment method	We accept all major credit cards. We do not accept debit cards or cheques.
Phone Calls	There is no cell phone reception here on the farm. If you need to make a call, please ask at reception or the pub. Calls are charged at R15 a call.
Picnics	There are several lovely places for you to go on a picnic. Guests often take the canoes up to the weir and picnic there. We can pack a picnic basket for you at R85 per person. Alcoholic beverages are extra.
Pipeline	The pipeline belongs to ESKOM who pump water from the Vygeboom Dam (below us) into the Nooitgedacht Dam just outside Carolina. From there the water is dispersed to various power stations eg. Arnot, Duvha, Hendrina, to name but a few.
Quad bikes	We offer different tours on the quad bikes. Have a look at the quad biking section on our website. Please note that this is a dangerous sport and you will be required to sign a disclaimer form before you may use the quads. You will be accompanied by a guide at all times.
River Rafting	In season, you can experience exhilarating River Rafting on the Komati River. Please note that this is a dangerous activity and River Rafting will not be allowed if the river is in flood or if the river is very low. We have a rubber boat available for rent, R500 deposit is required which will be returned to you if the boat is returned in good condition and R250 per person for the rent of the boat for 3 hours.
Rod hire	We have Fly Fishing Rods available for rent. The price is R 95 per day.
Room service	As a rule, we do not provide room service at Komati Gorge. However, if you need something please ask us at reception or pub/restaurant. We will do our best to accommodate you.
